

CASE STUDY

Background:

This property was part of the Bournville Village Trust. Our contract comprised of stripping all walls of wall paper and then re skimming completely. To cure the damp problem the existing concrete floor was taken up and re-laid to conform to up-to-date building regulations. A metre high of plaster was hacked off and replaced with a mixture of rendering sand and cement, after the walls were injected with damp retardant. All skirtingboards and doors were replaced along with joinery purpose made combination frames and windows. To finish off a new hardwood front door was fitted.
